## Sydney to Hobart Race

- 1. THE RACE is an offshore event open to sailing yachts of all types and sizes, to start on 26th December, 1945, and will be run under the authority and control of the Race Committee of the C.Y.C. in conjunction with the Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania. Yachts may be entered by members of any recognised Yacht Club, who will be granted Hon. Membership of the C.Y.C. for the purposes of the Race. The race will be run under the Royal Ocean Racing Club rating rule and time allowance.
- 2. RULES.—Y.R.A. Sailing Rules will apply with the following additional Regulations, and such Supplementary Regulations as the Committee may issue:—
  - (a) All yachts must exhibit their allotted racing number which shall be placed on each side of the mainsail at different heights. The owner's Club Pennant may be flown at the main truck in lieu of racing flag.
  - (b) All yachts must carry a serviceable dinghy securely lashed on deck. Serviceable collapsible boats are allowed.
  - (c) Any yachts carrying inside ballast must have this securely bolted or fastened in position.
  - (d) Every yacht shall carry at least one lifebuoy with attached waterlight in a convenient position and ready for instant use.
